- 1. Tuition reimbursement is available through Bancroft for qualified employees when you pass the class.
- 2. This class gives you the coursework you need to qualify for Registered Behavior Technician® (RBT) credential offered by the Behavior Analysis Certification Board and applies to your bachelor's degree at Rider if you decide to continue.
- The class will be taught on-site at Bancroft or on-line from 4-7 PM
- 4. The instructor is a Bancroft employee so you will gain a deeper understanding of how our programming impacts the behavior of the people at Bancroft.
- 5. Deferred billing is available through Rider, so you don't have to pay for the course up front.
